

These 8, of Ohio's 88, counties include 2.9 million people (25% of Ohio's
population) all within about 50 miles of Cleveland.

Annually the region has about 480 Enlisting Seniors from 130 high schools in 95 cities
including about 105 Army, 50 Navy, 40 Air Force, 140 Marine Corps, 5 Coast Guard,
130 Ohio Army National Guard & 10 Ohio Air Guard.

*Additionally including Enlisting Graduating Seniors from (1) Vermilion High School in Erie County,
(2) Black River High School in Ashland County, (3) Lake High School in Uniontown, Star County, and (4)
Chippewa High School in Doylestown, Wayne County.
