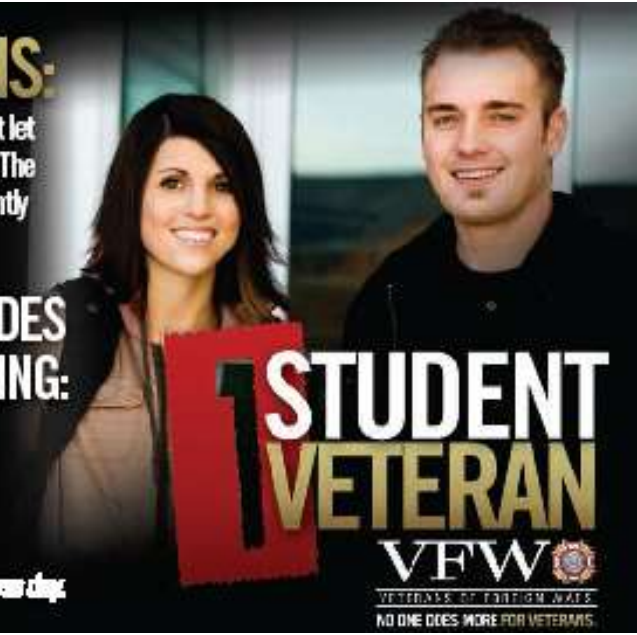

VFW Department of Ohio Scholarship Criteria 2016-2017

Purpose of Scholarship:

- To assist and encourage veterans to further their education. It has been designed to reach out to as many student veterans within the State of Ohio to further assist them in achieving their goals.

Selection Criteria:

- Applicant must be an Ohio Resident attending an Ohio College or College within a 75 mile radius of their residence
- Open to all veterans in the State of Ohio who have served in any foreign war, insurrection, or expedition, which service is recognized by the award of a campaign or service medal of the United States, served in Korea*, or has earned Hostile Fire or Imminent Danger Pay. (*Service on the Korean Peninsula, its airspace and territorial waters for 30 consecutive or 60 nonconsecutive days of duty)
- Must have been discharged under honorable or medical conditions.
- Military Members still serving are eligible if above criteria is met

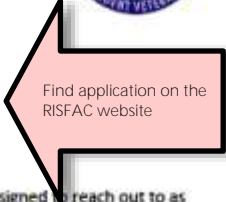
Scholarship Award:

- Five (5) scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded
- Scholarship will be awarded for 2017-2018 Academic Year
- Scholarship will be written directly to the college or university

Instructions to apply:

- Complete scholarship application and essay requirements (attached)
- Submit DD214 or LES for proof of eligibility
- Verification of Enrollment/Letter of Acceptance
- Return completed scholarship application and all requirements to the below address no later than March 31, 2017.
- Address: VFW Department of Ohio, P.O. Box 15219, Columbus, OH 43215 Attn: Scholarship Application

** If the semester is not completed, the money will be returned to student's account. If not used within one (1) year, the scholarship amount will be returned to the VFW Department of Ohio.

AMERICAN HERO SCHOLARSHIP to Camp CHOF

Dear friend,

Winter may be upon us, but each new day brings us closer to Camp CHOF's 40th summer in operation. Preparations are being made to ensure a great experience for campers in the coming summer! And we want to offer that experience to your family! We cannot express enough our appreciation to you for all the sacrifices you have made protecting us and our country's freedom every day. It is our prayer you'll consider the benefits Camp CHOF can provide to the lives of your children. Camp CHOF is 40+ acres of well maintained campgrounds that house an olympic sized swimming pool, water slide, climbing wall, paintball, challenge course, go-karts, ball fields, archery and much more!

WE HAVE A NEW SCHOLARSHIP TO OFFER. With the closing of 2016, we as a church and a camp have been hindered to reach out to those who serve and protect locally, for whom we support and pray for regularly. We are opening up a new scholarship program that will award children of CURRENT FULL TIME Police Officers, Firefighters, and First Response Personnel (EMT/Paramedics) a FREE WEEK OF CAMP! We are also once again offering a FREE WEEK AT CAMP CHOF to the children of military families whose parents or siblings are currently serving or who have served in a branch of the U.S. Military since 2003. You as a parent have the option of sending your child/children (ages 5-18) to stay one of our Resident or Day Camp Weeks- free of charge. Each child is encouraged to bring one friend each with him/her to share the experience. If your child's friend is from a non-military family and plans to attend Resident Camp, they will only pay the \$50 deposit fee or \$25 if they plan to attend Day Camp. The friend must fit the same age criteria for the camp week that your child will be attending. If your child is bringing a friend to attend Camp CHOF with him/her, your child and your child's friend should be registered at the same time to ensure they both make the cut since there is limited space - first come, first served. A friend's registration will not be guaranteed until your child is registered. Once we reach our limit, your child and/or your child's friend will be placed on a waiting list for a possible opening.
