
Truck Driving Academy

Veteran or Military Spouse Training Program

Tri-C has received a Department of Transportation grant to train military veterans or their spouses. All training and testing is included, excluding the Bureau of Criminal Investigation background check. The program also includes job placement assistance upon successful completion.

Eligibility Requirements:

- You must be 18 years or older
- Able to supply original high school diploma, GED or transcripts. Copies will only be accepted if they are in a sealed envelope sent directly from the high school
- No felonies (certain misdemeanors will be accepted on a case-by-case basis)
- Current Ohio driver's license with no restrictions
- No more than two points on driver's license in the last three years, and no more than one moving violation within the last three years
- BCI background check (completed after the program acceptance interview)
- Copy of DD214 with honorable discharge
- Successfully pass interview for acceptance into program
- Pass DOT physical and drug screen
- Able to attend one of the following class schedules:
 - Day session (5 weeks) Mon.-Th., 7 a.m. - 6 p.m.
 - Evening session (9 weeks) Mon.-Th., 6:30 - 11:30 p.m.
 - Weekend session (9 weeks) Sat. and Sun. 7 a.m. - 6 p.m.
