Program Overview

The U.S. Department of Defense provides online tutoring from Tutor.com at no cost to DoD service members. Eligible students can connect to a live tutor online at any time for one-to-one anonymous help with homework, test prep, proofreading and more in 40+ subjects. Eligible students can create an account and log in at www.tutor.com/military.

Free Around-the-Clock Help

Access to Tutor.com for eligible military-connected students is provided at no cost 24 hours a day, seven days a week—no appointment needed. Regardless of where they attend school or where they're stationed, students worldwide can access the online service using any internet-enabled device, including smart phones.

The service is available at no charge to all grades K-12 students and some adults in Active Duty, National Guard and Reserve families. Around the Clock Help

Students worldwide can connect to a tutor from any internet-enabled device, including smart phones and tablets 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Tutors are available every day of the year except January 1, July 4, U.S. Thanksgiving Day and December 25. On those four annual holidays, Tutor.com tutors are unavailable for 24 hours starting at 2:00 a.m. the day of the holiday (U.S. Eastern Time).

All Core Subjects, All Skill Levels

Students can get personalized help in 40 Math, Science, Social Studies, English and World Language subjects, including Algebra, Statistics, Biology, Essay Writing, Spanish, German and French. Tutors can also help students prepare for the SAT.

Students go to www.tutor.com/military and click the blue button showing their branch of service to get a tutor.

Students work one-to-one with a tutor in a secure, online classroom, which features an interactive whiteboard, file sharing and instant messaging.

Access to Tutor.com/military for DoD Active Duty and Reserve Service members is a DoD Pilot Program of limited duration, funded by the DoD Voluntary Education Program. Those who fund the program determine eligibility for its use. Long-term availability of the program is not guaranteed.
